

# LANDSCAPE & SANG



## SANG

The development proposals also include the provision of an area of accessible greenspace (SANG) to be provided within the northern woodland areas, this will comprise a series of paths and boardwalks allowing informal recreational use of this area whilst protecting the valuable habitats present.

## Landscape framework

The evolution of the landscape scheme has sought to focus on the retention of the existing woodland and boundary vegetation whilst providing a quantum of new tree, hedge and shrub planting within both public and private space. The open spaces have been conceived as integral part of the overall design concept. Spaces have been designed in conjunction with the architecture to create a series of individual character areas adding to the overall variety.

## Open Space

Open spaces are located to the edges of the proposed development area, connected through the middle by a central green which runs on an east-west axis. These spaces are designed to provide opportunity for connected walks interspersed with a series of five connected play spaces, swales and opportunities for new ecological habitat.
